General Info

Currency

Italy uses the Euro (€) as its official currency. Prices marked as EUR.
Banknotes (€5, €10, €20, €50, €100) and coins (50c, €1, €2) are widely used.
Electronic payment is also widely accepted.

Voltage & Power outlets

Italy uses a standard voltage of 230 V and a frequency of 50 Hz.
Power outlets are typically Type C, F, and L, so travelers may need a plug adapter depending on their devices.
Travelers from countries with 110–120V may need a voltage converter for non-dual-voltage devices.

General Info

Climate

The climate in L'Aquila in April is typically spring-like but unstable and sub-continental. The city sits in a mountain valley and thus experiences a wide daily temperature range (about 15 degrees C between day and night). Days begin to warm up with pleasant daytime highs, around 20 °C, but nights can remain cool or even cold (5°C in the early morning). Late frosts may still occur, along with frequent temperature fluctuations and rainfall.

Temperatures: Average afternoon highs in April range between 16 °C and 24 °C. Morning lows are generally cool and can sometimes be close to freezing in the early hours, especially during late cold-air intrusions.

Precipitation: April is a month when precipitation can be frequent, with rain showers caused by springtime atmospheric instability. The climatological chance of rain in that period is around 30%.

Wind: Mountain-valley breeze occurs frequently, with anabatic wind in the daytime and katabatic wind at nighttime.

Recommended clothing: Layered clothing is advised, including light jackets, sweatshirts, and long-sleeved shirts, and it is recommended to carry an umbrella or a waterproof jacket.

In summary, April is a transitional month in which L'Aquila shifts from the harsh winter climate to milder conditions, although cold and warm spells can occur.

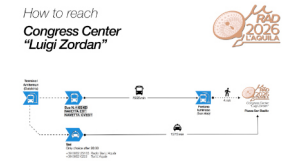

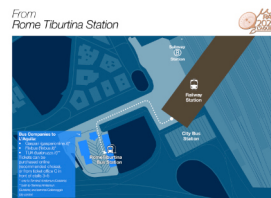

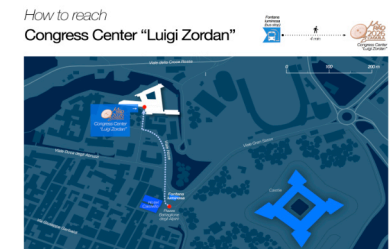

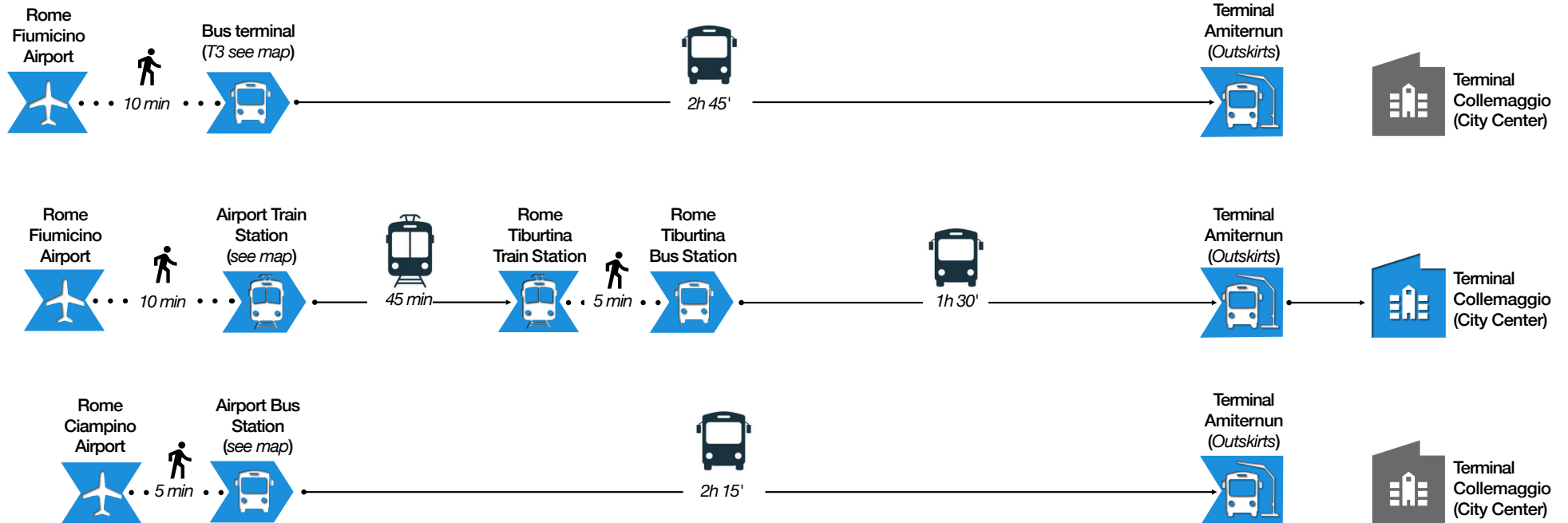

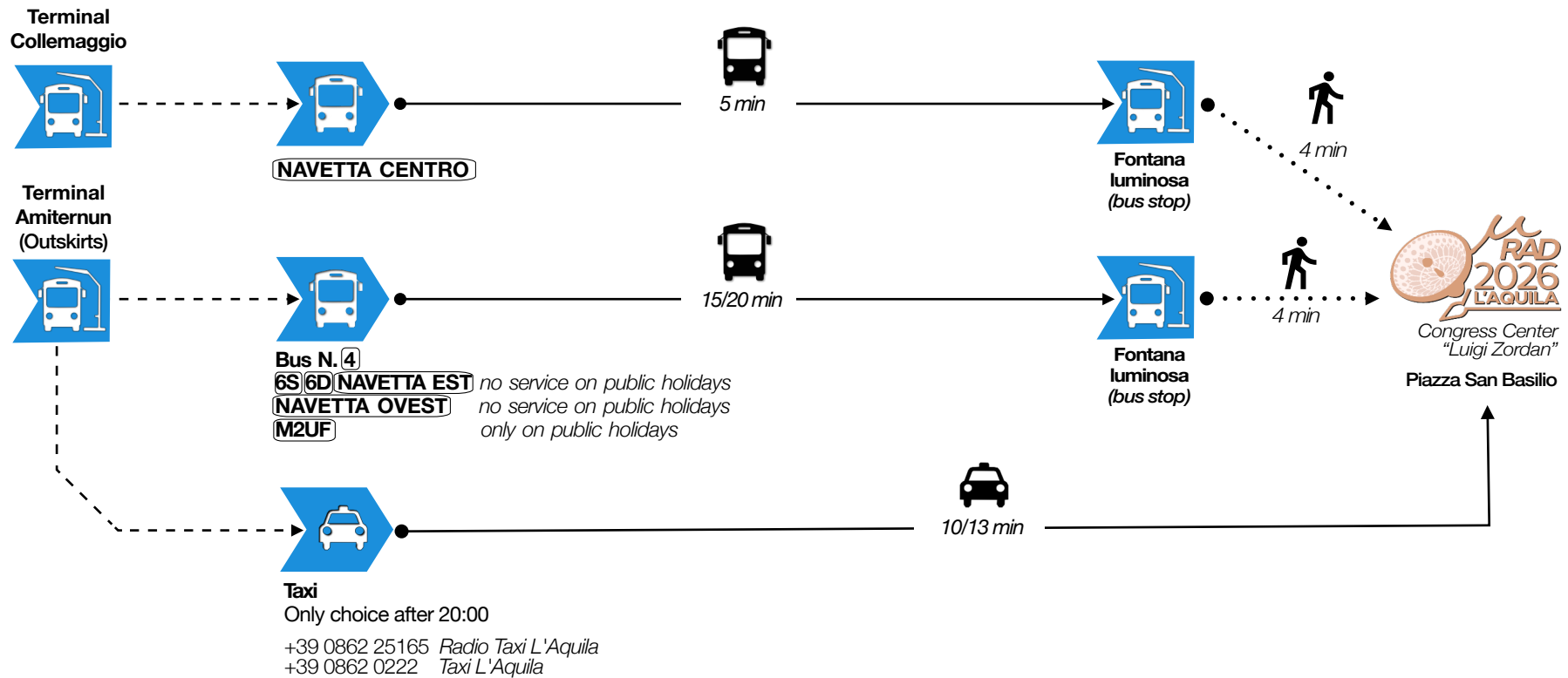

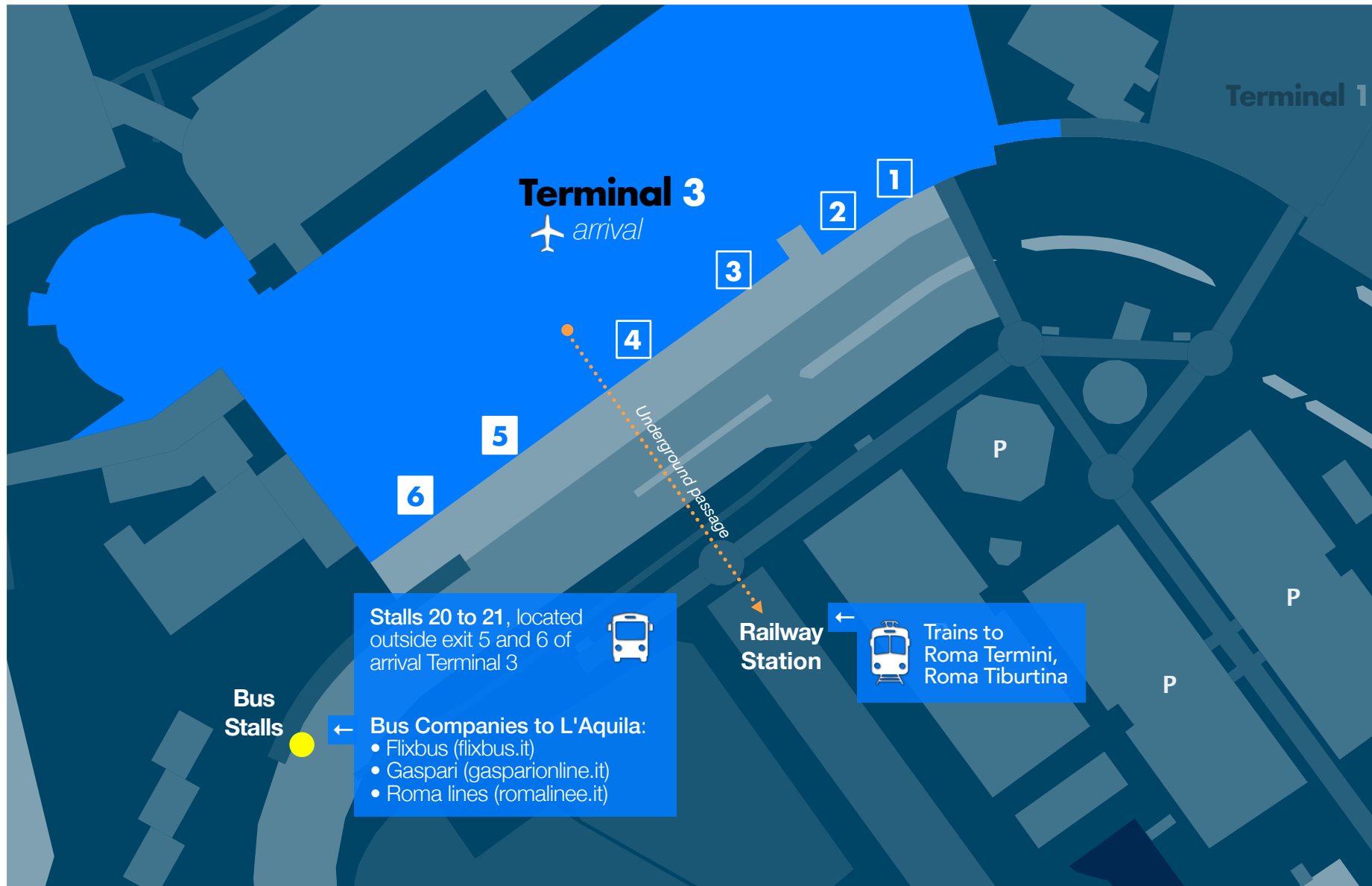

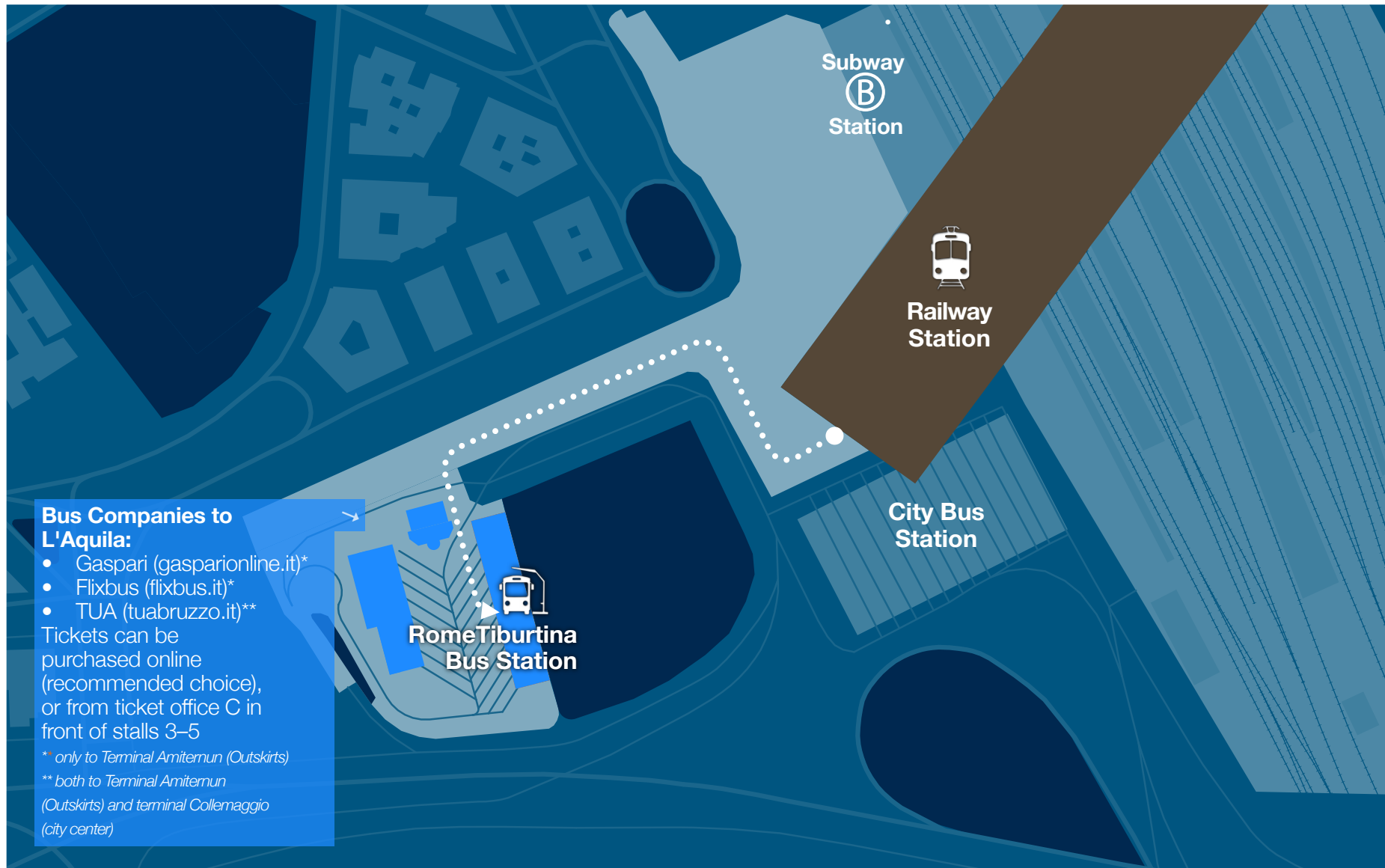

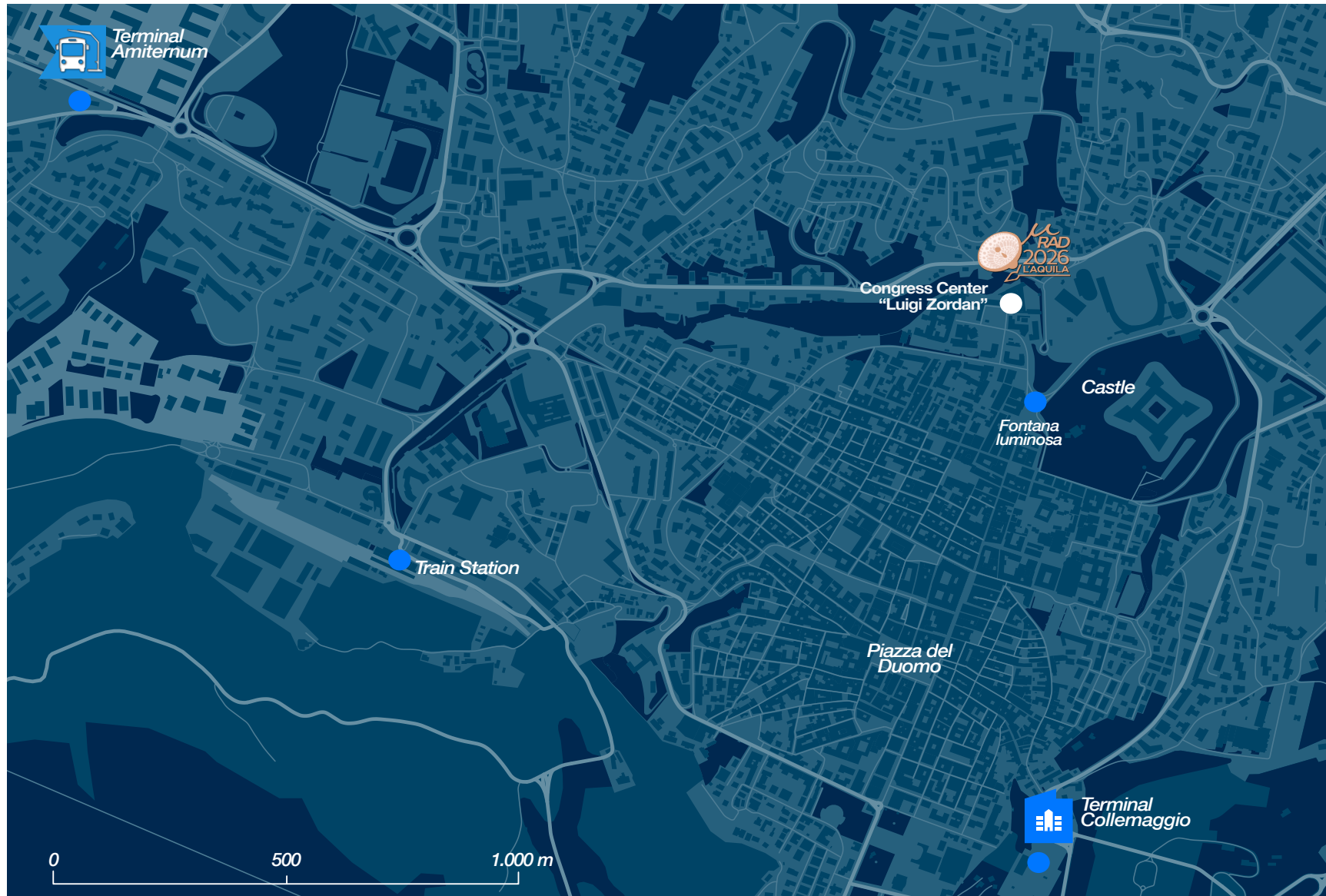
